



**SUBJ:** VATUSA Authorized Command Center Callsigns For Traffic Management Personnel

---

- 1. Purpose of This Notice.** This notice alerts VATUSA controlling personnel to the creation and authorization of specific VATUSA staff callsigns solely for the purpose of Command Center traffic management personnel usage.
- 2. Audience.** This notice applies to all VATUSA air traffic controllers and all VATUSA controllers performing traffic management duties under the direction of the Command Center.
- 3. Where Can I Find This Notice?** This notice is available on the VATUSA website.
- 4. Cancellation.** This notice is canceled upon the publication of VATUSA Order 7210.35A, Command Center General Standard Operating Procedures.
- 5. Explanation of Policy Change.** These callsigns are part of an effort to create a structured system for traffic management within VATUSA.
- 6. Procedures/Action.** No air traffic control procedures or actions are required.

The usage of the following callsigns is solely for the purpose of Command Center traffic management personnel and does not convey any permanent staff role for any individual using these callsigns:

VATUSA94  
VATUSA95  
VATUSA96  
VATUSA97  
VATUSA98

Users of these callsigns are authorized by the Command Center and VATUSA to perform traffic management functions during a VATUSA event when requested by the facility or by the Division, in cases like Friday Night Operations. The usage of the callsign is authorized up to one (1) hour prior to published event start and up to two (2) hours after the published event end time. Changes to allowed usage times can be authorized by VATUSA15 or VATUSA25 as necessary.

7. **Distribution.** This notice is distributed to all VATUSA facilities via the VATUSA website.
8. **Background.** This notice is being put in place as temporary authorization for the aforementioned callsigns until the release of VATUSA Order 7210.35A.
